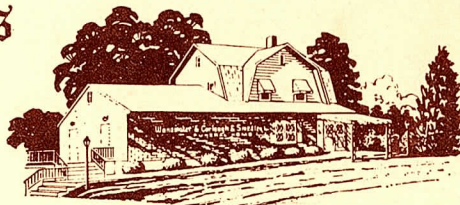

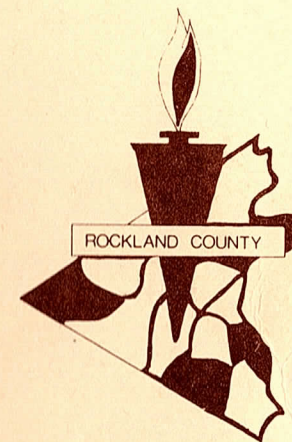

AUGUSTA BRADLEY CHAPMAN
1875-1949

Augusta Chapman, a lifelong Nyack resident, was one of the very best Women tennis players in the United States. Her tennis career lasted more than thirty years and her victories resulted in a collection of more than sixty beautiful silver cups, trophies and engraved bowls.

- 1899 Metropolitan Ladies Singles champion played in New York City.
- 1901, '02, '03 and '07 Hudson River L.T.A. Ladies singles champion.
- 1910 Nyack Country Club Women's tennis championship.
- 1914 Nyack Country Club Women's doubles with her daughter Marion as her partner.
- 1915 U.S.L.T.A. National Women's doubles finalist with Mrs. Marshall McLean as her partner.
- 1916 Challenged for National Singles championship. Lost to the reigning champion, Bessie Moore.
- 1917 Patriotic Women's doubles with Mrs. McLean. This tournament played in place of the National Championship due to the war. In the same year won the mixed doubles with Nathaniel Niles.
- 1918 Lost in the semi-finals of U.S.L.T.A. Women's doubles with her daughter, Marion, as her partner.

ENSHRINEMENT REQUIREMENT

The Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame was established to honor outstanding professional and amateur sportsmen, living and deceased, who have gained prominence while residing in Rockland County. To be considered for nomination to the Sports Hall of Fame, a prospective candidate must meet the following criteria:

- A. Attain prominence in either professional or amateur sports as a player, coach, manager, official, owner, writer or broadcaster.
- B. Have been a resident of Rockland County at the time of his or her prominence.
- C. Be a person of integrity and good character.
- D. A period of 5 years shall have elapsed since he or she gained prominence.

Nominations for consideration by the Hall of Fame Committee are solicited from the general public. Nominees are reviewed by the screening committee and then voted upon for inshrinement by the entire committee.

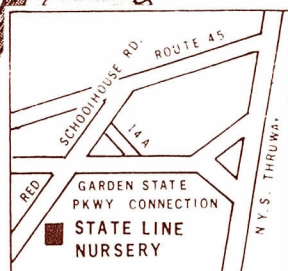

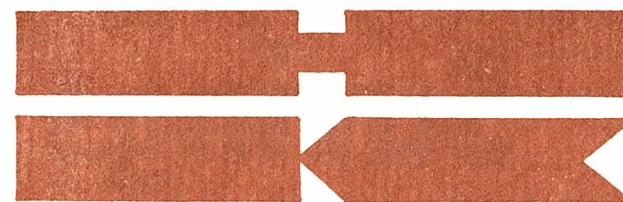
