ENSHRINEMENT REQUIREMENT

The Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame was established to honor outstanding professional and amateur sportsmen, living and deceased, who have gained prominence while residing in Rockland County. To be considered for nomination to the Sports Hall of Fame, a prospective candidate must meet the following criteria:

- A. Attain prominence in either professional or amateur sports as a player, coach, manager, official, owner, writer or broadcaster.
- B. Have been a resident of Rockland County at the time of his or her prominence.

C. Be a person of integrity and good character.

D. A period of 5 years shall have elapsed since he or she gained prominence.

Nominations for consideration by the Hall of Fame Committee are solicited from the general public. Nominees are reviewed by the screening committee and then voted upon for enshrinement by the entire committee.

DON CLANCY

In the early 1960's when Don Clancy's name was mentioned everyones thoughts turned to speed. Don started his track career at Nyack High School in 1960 running the 440 relay with Al Taylor, Ed Walker and Norm Daniels. Their time of 44.9 seconds set a new Nyack H.S. mark that year.

In 1962 "Dashin" Don, as he was known, started to chip away at the RCPSAL Track records. His races against Bob Goff of Spring Valley H.S. in the 100 yd. dash, 220 yd. dash and as anchor man of the 880 yd. relay produced the following results; he tied the 10.0 county record in the 100 yd. dash, ran the 220 in 22.7 and a new record time of 1:35.5 in the 880.

In 1963 Don ran again, only this year, his chief rival was present, Rockland County Hall of Famer, Jim Ashcroft, from Spring Valley H.S. Don lost only one race to Jim in their H.S. carers. 1963 was to be Don's year. In the County Meet he ran the 100 yd. dash in 9.8 seconds becoming the third runner in Rockland County history to break the 10.0 mark. He then ran the 220 yd. dash in 22.0. Don came in 3rd place in the 100 yd. dash in New York State that year running a 9.75, the winners tied at 9.70. Don was All County Track for 4 yrs., while at Nyack High School.

Don did not only excel at track, he was all County Football for two years and played halfback on offense and in the defensive secondary. He played on the Nyack H.S. 1962 team that were co-champs with Haverstraw H.S. that year.

1976-77 Sophomore Year

Starter on Pearl River High School Girls Varsity Basketball Team; Won County Division Championship. Placed second in county; Received First Team All County Honors - Unanimous vote; Third in league in scoring - 344 pints - 20 points per game.

1977-78 Junior Year

Pre-Season Play: Most Valuable Player of Pearl River Invitational Basketball Tournament; First Team All County; Team Captain; Most Valuable Player - 20.4 PPG; Scored 43 points in one game. Third highest in Rockland County history of Girls' Basketball; Rockland Co. P.S.A.L. Division Champions; State Section IX Runner Up; Chosen to represent Region 2 in New Yorks' Empire State Games.

1978-79 Senior Year

First Team All County - Unanimous - Third Year; Team Captain - Basketball; Most Valuable Player - 20.6 PPG; First Girls ever in Rockland County Girls Basketball history to score 1,000 points; Total career points - 1,476; All American Nominee for Scholastic Coach Magazine - Pending First girl ever in Rockland County Basketball history to have her uniform number "22" retired; Led her high school basketball team to the: Division Championship, County P.S.A.L. Championship, State Section IX Championship, Intersectional State Championship; Named to the Adidas Scholastic Coach Magazine All-American Girls' Basketball Team; Named to the 1979 Prep All-American Girls' Sports Team.



ABRAHAM SCHUSTER

Sports participation while a student at Spring Valley High School (1/44 - 6/47): soccer squad - three years (1 year J.V., 2 years varsity), mostly halfback, varsity track manager - one year, wrestling - four years.

Made the varsity team as an 8th grader, wrestling at 95 pounds (even though he only weighed 85 pounds). Missed 8th grade graduation in Jan. to wrestle his first varsity match against Suffern, which he won!

Wrestled varsity for four years, losing only four matches in all that time. As a freshman he was 2nd place, 95 pounds, in the County Championship.

As a sophomore, he was undefeated all year at 103 pounds and took first place in the County. The SVHS team was County Champs that year.

As a senior, he was undefeated all year at 120 and took first place in the County. He was the team's co-captain.

In 1947 he took first place, at 120, in the Rockland County All Star Tournament.

He was the founder and first president of the Rockland County Wrestling Officials; refereed countless county, sectional, and invitational wrestling tournaments, soccer games, & track meets; judge at National AAU Wrestling Championships - 1966; table official for the first ever USSR vs. USA Wrestling meet, at the New York Athletic Club in 1958; honored by the Ramsey High School Athletic Department and the Superintendent of Schools, on the occasion of their twentieth year of soccer, for having started soccer at Ramsey.

1954 - Great Falls, Montana (Class "C") 15-7 Record.

1955 - Newport News, Virginia (Class "B") 19-7 Record, received M.V.P. Award, All-Star Team.




