ENSHRINEMENT REQUIREMENT

The Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame was established to honor outstanding professional and amateur sportsmen, living and deceased, who have gained prominence while residing in Rockland County. To be considered for nomination to the Sports Hall of Fame, a prospective candidate must meet the following criteria:

- A. Attain prominence in either professional or amateur sports as a player, coach, manager, official, owner, writer or broadcaster.
- B. Have been a resident of Rockland County at the time of his or her prominence.
- C. Be a person of integrity and good character.
- D. A period of 5 years shall have elapsed since he or she gained prominence.

Nominations for consideration by the Hall of Fame Committee are solicited from the general public. Nominees are reviewed by the screening committee and then voted upon for enshrinement by the entire committee.



MURRAY OLDERMAN

Murray Olderman, whose formative years were spent in Spring Valley, is a nationally acclaimed sports columnist, cartoonist and author while remaining active athletically most of his life.

His start in sports was at the <u>Rockland Leader</u>, where he served as sports editor and columnist (under the pseudonym of "Dave Morris") in 1937 and 1938 while still in high school -- he went all the way through the Spring Valley school system. He was also on that county weekly in parts of 1939 and 1940. His sports cartoons were first published in Nyack <u>Journal-News</u> in the 1940's.

In 1952, he joined a Scripps-Howard syndicate, Newspaper Enterprise Association, and progressed to sports editor, executive editor and contributing editor before retiring in 1987. His work was distributed to 800 daily newspapers for 35 years, his columns and cartoons apearing in such publications as the New York World Telegram & Sun, the Pittsburgh Press, the Detroit News and the Chicago Daily News. Among the events he has covered are the World Series, all 24 Super Bowls to date, the winter and summer Olympic Games, the Kentucky Derby, the Final Four, and all major bowl games, Wimbledon, the Masters and the U.S. Open, the World Cup, the Indianapolis 500 and heavyweight championship bouts from Rocky Marciano to Mike Tyson.

As an author, Olderman has written 11 sports books -- among them The Pro Quarterback (Prentice-Hall), SUPER!: 'Just Win, Baby' (Los Angeles Raiders), STARR (William Morrow) -- and edited a series of sports books for Prentice-Hall. His subjects have included football, baseball, basketball, boxing, golf and tennis. He also did the illustrations for most of his books and the covers for several of them, such as the 20th Century Encyclopedia of Baseball and Raging Bull, by Jake La Motta.

As a youth, Olderman played sandlot baseball and softball in Rockland County and freshman baseball at the University of North Carolina. He won the city tennis championship while residing in Leonia, N.J., and later participated in celebrity ski races. In tennis, his primary avocation, he has also twice won the Super Bowl Media Tennis Tournament, the National Cartoonists Society tennis championship and the club championship at Mission Hills Country Club in Rancho Mirage, Calif., where he currently resides with his wife, Nancy. They have three grown children and five grand-children.

He remains professionally active as a free-lance writer and artist.



JEROME BONOMOLO

Jerome, better known as Jerry, has dedicated his coaching energies in the best interest of Rockland County's student athletes. His knowledge of sports combined with his spirit for life has helped shape the minds and bodies of young men and women in physical education classes and on the athletic fields for two decades. 


JOSEPH "BISCUIT" PICARELLO

Nyack High School (1966-70): Four years varsity baseball outfielder ... offered contracts by Yankees and Red Sox ... chosen all-county, all metro and all-state ... drafted in fourth round by Chicago White Sox on graduation ... Two years varsity soccer under Frank Nelson ... two years varsity football under Paul Lankau ... placekicker first year, quarterback in senior season ... team won every game he quarterbacked, as well as PSAL title ... WRKL all-county and quarterback of the year.


University of North Carolina (1970-74): Full baseball scholarship ... elected captain senior year ... All-Atlantic Coast Conference centerfielder last two years ... played Cape Cod summer league and was all-star centerfielder each year.

Junior and senior year at UNC was also full-time punter for Tar Heels football team ... finished in top ten in country in punting junior year ... punted in Sun Bowl for ACC championship team in both 1972 and 1973.

Post college career: Signed with New York Mets after graduation and played one year at Batavia ... lead outfielders in batting ... played New York Penn League ... had kicking tryouts with both New Orleans Saints (played entire pre-season 1974) and New York Jets (cut by Lou Holtz).

Current Sports: Ranked in top eight in both singles and doubles in Rockland County for last five years in men's tennis ... plays national circuit in Platform tennis and has been regionally ranked with two different partners.

Personal: Lives in Valley Cottage with wife Linda and daughter Caroline. Runs the Lydecker Agency in Nyack, a real estate and insurance concern.



JOHN MERCURIO

John Mercurio - Tappan Zee H.S., Manhattan College, Seton Hall University:

Baseball - First team All-County, Manhattan College - 3 years varsity314 batting average (struck out 6 times in 3 years ... was called out three of those times by bad umpire calls, only went down swinging 3 times), Semi-Pro baseball with Country Welders, Spring Valley Bengels and Emerson-Westwood Merchants (8 years).

Basketball - Second team All-County, Rockland County Men's League (8 years average 15 points per game).

Football - Honorable Mention.

Softball - 39 consecutive years of Rockland County softball, never batted below .300, 13 years Major Leage Softball ... Hawthorne Chevies, Eastern Seaboard League, played on 10 New Jersey State Championship teams, went to the World Fast Pitch Tournament twice, Rockland Counties only softball player to play in a Professional Softball League. Home games were held in Philadelphia Phillies Veterans Stadium. (1 Year). Greatest softball achievement: won the batting title and MVP in a New Jersey, New York, Connecticut Regional Tournament going 11 for 17 for a .647 batting average.

Sports Writer - have written 40 books in the last 9 years. Four have been published with a fifth coming out in March of 1990.


