ENSHRINEMENT REQUIREMENT

The Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame was established to honor outstanding professional and amateur sportsmen, living and deceased, who have gained prominence while residing in Rockland County. To be considered for nomination to the Sports Hall of Fame, a prospective candidate must meet the following criteria:

- A. Attain prominence in either professional or amateur sports as a player, coach, manager, official, owner, writer or broadcaster.
- B. Have been a resident of Rockland County at the time of his or her prominence.
- C. Be a person of integrity and good character.
- D. A period of 5 years shall have elapsed since he or she gained prominence.

Nominations for consideration by the Hall of Fame Committee are solicited from the general public. Nominees are reviewed by the screening committee and then voted upon for enshrinement by the entire committee.



JIM KANE

As the long time assignor of officials for this county, he was on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to make sure our games were always covered. Also, in case of postponement due to weather, he always flawlessly handled reassignments to the next day.

Personal - Life long Rockland County resident. Born September 26, 1927 (64 years old). Graduated Nyack High School - 1945. U.S. Navy - 1945-48. Banker - 1949 to present.


Sports Participant - Varsity Basketball at Nyack High School, Varsity Baseball at Nyack High School, Semi-pro Basketball & Softball in Rockland County from approx. 1948-58: (Pederson Sparklers-basketball and softball, Nyack American Legion - basketball, Letchworth Big 5 - basketball, Nyack Recreation League.) Participated in many tournaments: Letchworth, Haverstraw & Rockland State. Positions: Basketball - back court, Softball - underhand pitcher. Also, won several Rockland County (Father/Son) Tennis Championships with son, Kevin.

Sport Official - Started in 1943, while a student at Nyack High School. Got his start so young because all the regular officials were involved in World War II. In the early days officiated mostly at Nyack YMCA and Nyack College in baseball, soccer and basketball. Began officiating the RCPSAL in 1953 and has worked the following sports on both high school and college levels: basketball (boys & girls), soccer (boys & girls), football, baseball, and volleyball. Also, a long time tennis official and worked the chair at all the big tournaments at the Nyack Field Club.

Assignor of Officials - Started in 1969 and assigned officials to every contest from junior High, Fresh, Junior Varsity, Varsity to college teams that played in the county including the following sports: (this included scrimmages, games and tournaments - boys & girls). Football, soccer, hockey, swimming, volleyball, gymnastics, basketball, wrestling, winter track, lacrosse, baseball, softball, and spring track.

A conservative estimate that from 1969 - 1989, Jimmy did 10,000 assignments a year for a staggering 200,000 assignments and the greatest testament to his dedication is that he never had a game canceled because of lack of officials.

With the inclusion of Rockland County into Section One, Jimmy's full time status gave way to the BOCES Computer, but he still continues, to this day, to be actively involved.



JAY A. BOHNEL

Considered by many as one of the top running backs in Pearl River High School Football History, Jay Bohnel has this year been selected to the Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame.

A graduate of the class of 1959, Bohnel led the Pirates 1958 football team to the Rockland County Championship. Second in scoring that season, Jay was a unanimous first team All-County selection. During his three years as a starting running back for Pearl River, Jay scored more than 20 touchdowns, many on runs of 50 yards or more.

Although Jay has received most of his recognition on the football field, he was also an outstanding baseball player, basketball player and because of his excellent speed, spent one season as an 880 runner in track. As a baseball player, he was a varsity starter as a 14 year old Freshman. He played 3 years of varsity basketball and in his Sophomore year, broke the county 880 record, although finishing second to Eugene Martin of T.Z. at the county meet.

Following high school, Jay went onto a very successful football career at Rutgers University where he was a major contributor to Coach John Bateman's memorable 10-0 season.

Among his other accomplishments following high school and college, Bohnel was one of the backbones in the formation of Pearl River's Buc 11 Gridiron Club in the late 60's and the very successful Pearl River Alumni Football program. Jay is presently very involved as an assistant coach to Nate Salant with the highly regarded OTB Pirates of Spring Valley.

Jay is also quite proud to say that his first 2 baseball coaches are presently members of the Rockland County Sports Hall of Fame, Harry Jackson and the late Brit Patterson.

Averaged just over 20 points per game each year. Ramapo High School MVP 3 straight years in a row. Played the first Star Basketball Summer Classic in 1977. Coached by Izzy Bordanick. *Starting forward on championship team, MVP for the Classic. Starting forward on 1978 Exceptional Seniors Game, Coached by Barry Register. Starting forward on the first Empire State Games Women's Open Team *Won bronze medal in Syracuse. Awarded basketball scholarship to Niagara University (Division II school), earned starting role towards end of season, Coached by Mary Roickle, averaged 11 points per game 5 rebounds, placed 3rd in NAIA Nationals in Fargo, North Dakota 1979, (left Niagra and graduated from Pace, 1982).






